Course Description

Amendment 12 to PANS-OPS became effective 25th of November 2004. It carries some major changes which will greatly enhance both the flexibility and the safety of the Procedure Design process, The new chapters include GNSS SBAS departures, GNSS GBAS approach as well as totally revised APV/BARO-VNAV criteria to name just a few things.

This intensive five-day course will help the Procedure Specialist to apply the new or revised criteria immediately when performing his daily duties. He will also learn what impact revised criteria can have on existing published procedures.
