Course Objective

To introduce training techniques to experienced procedure designers to enable them to give initial PANS OPS training to personnel joining an Instrument Procedure Design Team.

Participants

Participants should be current procedure designers who have at least 5 years experience using all aspects of ICAO Doc 8168 (PANS OPS) criteria.

Course Description

The course is designed to introduce instructional techniques to experienced Procedures Designers. Course and lesson planning and the use of Microsoft Powerpoint, the OHP and flip chart, as teaching aids will be an integral part of the course. Participants will be required to plan and present selected modules from the ICAO Doc 8168.

By the end of the course the participants will be able to plan, generate visual aids and have experience of delivering a teaching module.
