WX1 Advanced

Course Objective

At the end of this course, the participant will be familiar with a wider series of applications within the Wx1 Series of Software.

Basic Topics Covered

A brief refresher of all the original modules of the Wx1.

Additional Topics Covered

An "in-depth" review of recent additional modules, and updates to the programme, with which participants may be unfamiliar. An introduction to modules under development.

Participants

The student must have attended a Wx1 Basic Course or be able to demonstrate familiarity with the system by providing a reference letter from a recognised Wx1 user.

Course Description

Few Instrument Procedure Designers get the opportunity to use all the functions contained within the Wx1 Software in their normal working tasks. Wx1 is a living programme and modules are periodically reviewed, improved and updated. Amendments to ICAO doc 8168 are also incorporated into the programme to coincide with the Amendment publication date.

The Wx1 Advanced Course has been designed to ensure that experienced users are made fully conversant with all modules that are currently in the Wx1 programme.

The course is designed to be flexible so that any modules of particular interest to participants can be covered in detail.

Custom Topics Covered

Participants should advise the Course Administrator of any modules with which they require particular help.

The Course Instructor will incorporate as many of these items as possible into a customised course programme.

Exercises

The whole theory is backed up with group exercises to enhance the learning effect. The group exercises and their presentation are part of the final examination. All exercises are made on a fictitious airport with a series of obstacles in strategic locations.
